Fujiva Hotel opened in Hakone in 1878 as Japan's first authentic resort hotel. The hotel consists of a unique group of buildings that are a mixture of Japanese and Western styles, created by carpenters and ideas of successive presidents, who were architectural enthusiasts. The hotel was designated as a cultural asset in 1997. There is a staff known as Mr. Preserver called Eizensan who is in charge of building construction and repairs in this long - established hotel. Although few people know about it because it is a rare example these days, one of the reasons why Fujiya Hotel still retains the atmosphere of its founding days is due to the work of them behind the scenes. This book introduces the highlights of Fujiya Hotel's unique architecture, along with the behind - the - scenes work of Eizensan by taking the opportunity of the hotel's two-year closure for renovation having been started in April 2018. Also this not only describes their daily maintenance and major works such as the bridge in the garden, water wheel, and *hinoki* bath, but also provides a wealth of illustrations showing the front and back of Fujiya Hotel, including the precious back yard.
